

Warrior Lacrosse NO Tolerance Agreement

- Players that fail to participate in a team scheduled event (practice, games, etc) without prior consent of the head coach of the specific team (**Varsity, JV, Freshman, Developmental, Youth**) Notification must be made at least 2 hours before a missed practice and one week prior to a missed game. Emergency exceptions may be granted on an individual basis, provided the coaching staff is notified in a timely manner.

An unexcused absence from practice=game suspension, but the player must still attend game(s) in uniform, until the suspension expires.

- Players must have an attitude of respect and compliance at all times for all members of the coaching staff and team members. Verbal or physical abuse of a coach or team member will be dealt with, with the appropriate disciplinary action. Physical abuse is defined as pushing or shoving, hitting, or assaulting.

“Talking back”, not paying attention, ignoring direction, etc. will result in the player being asked to do conditioning drills. Physical abuse, will result in dismissal from the team .

- Players and parents must demonstrate a sportsman-like attitude to all opposing players, coaches, all fans and officials and to anyone present at any team event.
- Players and or Parents may not speak to an official. Players may speak if, they are appointed team captain or have been addressed by an official. Conversation with the officials must remain in a professional and respectful manner
- Players or spectators may not, under any circumstances, fight or enter into a fight on the game field, even for the purpose of breaking up an altercation. Players may not fight during practices or any other team event.

Anyone not abiding by this rule will be subject to game dismissal and will be asked to leave the field and hosting game site. Players will be subject to disciplinary actions. Fighting will result in game dismissal.

- Usage of controlled substances, tobacco products or alcohol by any player or spectator on game site property is strictly prohibited.

Breaches of this rule will result in removal from the game site property and or dismissal from the team.

- Time and Place – if a player or parent disagrees with a coach or feels that special circumstances have prohibited them from following the rules of the club, the appropriate time and place to discuss that with the coach and an executive board member is after practice and away from the team
- Eligibility clause per MSHAA and Fox High School handbook – Must be a creditable citizen – both in school and out of school. Conduct by the player involving law enforcement should be reported to the head coach as your conduct may affect eligibility or contest outcomes.
- You must have earned, the preceding semester of attendance, a minimum of 2.50 units of credit or have earned credit in 70% of the maximum allowable classes.
- Must be enrolled in and regularly attending courses that offer 2.5 units of credit or 70% of the maximum allowable credits which may be earned whichever is greater for your school.

- If a player violates any of the club rules, that player may be put on probation, be suspended, or removed from the team without receiving any refund from the club at the discretion of the executive board. Any and all appeals will be addressed on a case by case basis by the executive board.
